

Water Sewer Board Meeting 2-20-2018

Attendance: Ron Mills, Elgon Ellis, Dan Jere, Paul Fox, Rich Phillips

Next meeting is scheduled for February 20th 6:00 pm

- Rich gave a list of manholes that have been inspected along with the use of the push camera. 10 manholes have been inspected along with the great results of using the push camera looking into lateral lines. Going into spring runoff it will be valuable to use the camera system to look into some of the water infiltration problems and setting a production schedule for the camera system to ensure that it is being utilized productively, even if it means employing temporary crews to perform the inspection of the sewers and manholes.
- Discussion of the sewer line that is on Railroad St at the back of the properties and that sewer needs to be flushed on an annual basis to keep from backing up. Conversation began at looking at running a new sewer line out in front of the homes in Railroad St and terminating the sewers in the back of the property.
- Janet LaBlac had a broken water line in the basement of her house on a Saturday. Rich shut the water off and made the repairs and will be billed accordingly.
- Discussion began on what defines commercial and residential for rental and how the rates may apply. After discussion the issue is tabled until better data is available from Bill Beaune and even have Bill at a meeting to help explain the rates and effects of making any discussion.
- Confined space training was brought up again and that anyone entering a sewer will need to have the training and also equipment.
- Pump 5 and 6 pre-cleaning of grease to prevent back-ups and pump failures was performed and will be billed accordingly to the tribe.
- The March meeting will be cancelled due to Dan Jere not being in town the night of the meeting, the next scheduled meeting will be April 17th at 6pm.
