Superior Township, Brimley Michigan Ordinance 2023-21 Code of Conduct

Preamble

An Ordinance to confirm Code of Conduct

The Township of Superior, Chippewa County Michigan, Ordains

Section 1: Scope, Purpose and Intent

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority granted the Township Board under the Township Ordinances Act MCL 41.181 et seq., to establish a code of conduct ordinance for Township officials and limitations provided by those Acts and subject to terms and conditions of this ordinance and any future amendments to this ordinance.

Section 2: Purpose

The proper operation of government requires that public officials of Superior Township represent the Township in a professional manner, not benefit from being associated with the Township or owe the Township money.

Section 3

- 1. Any Township volunteer or appointed board/ committee member who owes the Township money will be ineligible to serve in their respective role. Once an individual has been determined to owe funds, they will have 30 days to become current prior to being removed from their position.
- 2. Any Township volunteer, or appointed board / committee member who is disruptive or disrespectful at any township function will be removed from their position upon a majority vote of the Township Board.
- 3. No Township Board member, committee member, employee or volunteer may accept any item of value from the Township without Board approval and paying fair market value.
- 4. No Township Board Member, committee member, employee or volunteer may use their position to personally benefit themselves or their family members.

Section 4

The Township Board will make the final determination as to whether there has been a breach of Township Code of Conduct and will retain the right per majority vote, to determine appropriate remedies

Section 5

This Ordinance shall take effect on the date of its publication
