Meeting called to order by Supervisor R. Phillips at 6:00 pm

Pledge of Allegiance

Public Comment: question on Kayak launch and dock.

Motion by G. Kinsella and supported by W. Beaune to approve the agenda with the addition of the park flagpole added to old business. Motion passed with all Members voting yes.

Motion by R. Phillips and supported by G. Kinsella to approve the minutes of Regular board meeting Minutes of June 22, 2021. Motion passed with all Members voting yes.

New Business:

Vince Gross address the Board about the property owned by J. Miller at the corner of M-221 and Water tower Drive. Mr. Gross has made several complaints over the years about the upkeep of the lawn and the condition of the home. He was asking the Board support Township ordinance 7 and enforce the fines to the property owner as set forth in the ordinance. Discussion was held.

**Water and Sewer Department:**

R. Phillis reported that they are doing a lot of Miss Digs for the cable being put in through out the town. Pump station 1, had issues with someone putting large items in the sewer. Lift station 3 is down to one pump, the other is out to be repaired. Lift station 6 is having issues again with grease.

Motion by G. Kinsella and supported by S. Kniskern to adopted the tax levy at 1.6496 for the township operating millages. Motion passes with all Members voting yes

Motion by W. Beaune and supported by R. Phillips to accept the Treasure's report for June 30, 2021 as presented. Motion passes with all Members voting yes.

R. Phillips reported that the County jail workers cleaned up the cemeteries and other township areas.
