ITEMS NOT accepted: batteries, burn barrels, computer hardware, hazardous waste, liquids, appliances (i.e. refrigerators, water heaters, furnaces, and lawnmowers), medical waste, PCBs, raw septic waste, tires, yard waste, or returnable beverage containers.

Superior Township Chippewa County, Michigan Blight Ordinance,
Ordinance No. 7: Section II. Causes of Blight or Blighting Factors

In any area, the storage or accumulation of junk, trash, rubbish or refuse except domestic refuse stored in such a manner as not to create a nuisance for a period not to exceed 30 days. The term "junk" shall include parts of machinery or motor vehicles, unused stoves or other appliances stored in the open, remnants of woods, metal or any other material or other cast-off material of any kind whether or not the same could be put to any reasonable use. No blight shall occur if the "junk" material is stored out of the sight of all roads, highways and/or neighborhood properties.
