If the vehicle is not yours and is abandoned on your property, you may contact a local towing company to have the abandoned vehicle removed. Under MI law a person shall not abandon a vehicle or vessel in the state. Refer to MCL 257.252a, 80130f, 81151 or 82161 2014 PA549.
