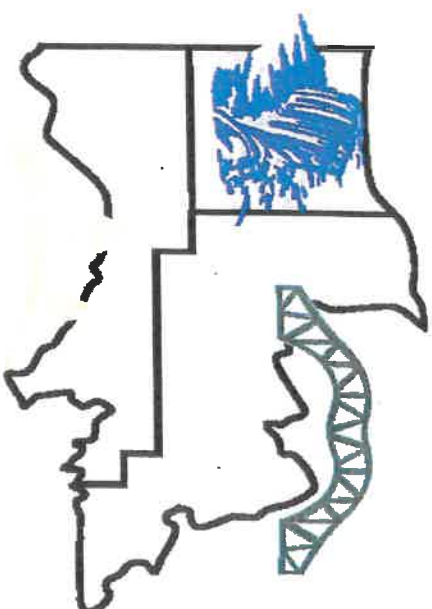

Early Head Start:

Center Based:

Full day, year round program designed for children ages 6 weeks to 36 months (3 years).

Home Based:

90 minute visits for infants, toddlers up to 36 months (3 years), pregnant women and their families.

Head Start:

School day and part day options available for children ages 3 and 4 years old. Centers are located in Brimley, Cedarville, Drummond Island, Kinross, Newberry, Sault Ste Marie, and St. Ignace.

Great Start Readiness Program:

Provides a strong focus on healthy child development essential for school readiness for children age 4 by September 1. Classrooms are located in Brimley, Cedarville, Drummond Island, Sault Ste. Marie and St. Ignace.

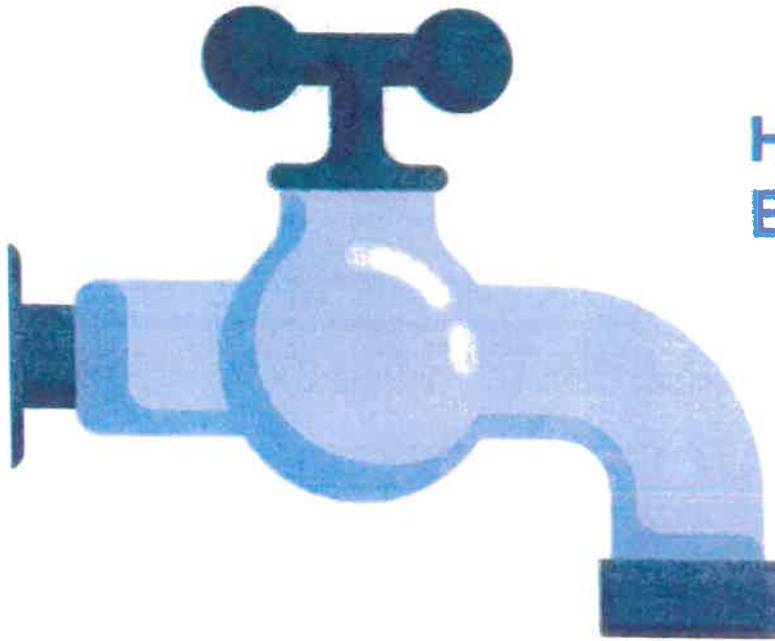
