

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 6  
BEING AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE  
OF THE CHIPPEWA COUNTY WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM NO. 1 (TOWNSHIP  
OF SUPERIOR) ON A PUBLIC UTILITY BASIS UNDER THE PROVISIONS  
OF ACT 94, PUBLIC ACTS OF MICHIGAN, 1933, AS AMENDED.

THE TOWNSHIP OF SUPERIOR HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 6 being  
an ordinance to provide for the operation and maintenance of  
the Chippewa County Water Supply System No. 1 (Township of  
Superior) on a public utility basis under the provisions of  
Act 94, Public Acts of Michigan, 1933, as amended, is hereby  
amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. Effective October 1, 1980,  
rates to be charged for service furnished by  
the System shall be as follows:

3,001-15,000 cu.ft. per quarter	\$1.30 per 100 cu.ft. or fraction thereof
All over 15,000 cu.ft. per quarter	\$1.00 per 100 cu.ft. or fraction thereof

### SPECIAL RATES

For miscellaneous or special services for which a special rate shall be established, such rates shall be fixed by the Township Board.

### BILLING

Bills will be rendered quarterly on October 1, January 1, April 1 and July 1, or on such other dates as may be fixed by the Township Board, payable without penalty within thirty (30) days after the date thereon. Payments received after such period shall bear a penalty of five per cent (5%) of the amount of the bill.

The charge for service for any period of less than one quarter shall be the monthly rate for each month or fraction of a month.

### Enforcement

The charges for services which are under the provisions of Section 21, Act 94, Public Acts of Michigan, 1933, as amended, made a lien on all premises served thereby, unless notice is given that a tenant is responsible, are hereby recognized to constitute such lien, and whenever any such charge against any piece of property shall be delinquent for six (6) months, the Township official or officials in charge of the collection thereof shall certify annually, on August 1st of each year, to the tax-assessing officer of the Township the facts of such delinquency, whereupon such charge shall be by him entered upon the next tax roll as a charge against such premises and shall be collected and the lien thereof enforced, in the same manner as general township taxes against such premises are collected and the lien thereof enforced: Provided, however, where notice is given that a tenant is responsible for such charges and service as provided by said Section 21, no further service shall be rendered such premises until a cash deposit in the amount of \$25 shall have been made as security for payment of such charges and service.

In addition to the foregoing, the Township shall have the right to shut off water service to any premises for which charges for water service are more than three (3) months delinquent, and such service shall not be reestablished until all delinquent charges and penalties and a turn-on charge, to be specified by the Township Board, have been paid. Further, such charges and penalties may be recovered by the Township by court action."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take immediate

effect.


