

ORDINANCE NO. 14

SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP
CHIPPEWA COUNTY

An ordinance to regulate the speed of vessels and to provide for the safe use of the waters in Superior Township, Chippewa County; enacted under the authority of Act 303, Public Acts of 1967, as amended (M.S.A. 18.1287 (17)), being identical to State Administrative Rules filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.

THE TOWNSHIP OF SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP.

SECTION I

All words and phrases used in this ordinance shall be construed and have the same meanings as those words and phrases defined in Act 303, P.A. 1967, as amended, M.S.A. 18.1287 (8).

SECTION II

Filed with the Secretary of State on August 4, 1980 These rules take effect 15 days after filing with the Secretary of State.

Regulation No. 17, Chippewa County.

R 281.717.9. Waiska river; slow-no wake speed.

Rule 9. On that portion of the Waiska river located in sections 2, 4, 5, 9, 10, and 11, T46N, R2W, Superior Township, Chippewa County, it is unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow-no wake speed.

SECTION III

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV

Violations of this ordinance are a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) together with costs of prosecution or imprisonment in the county jail or such other place of detention as the court may prescribe, for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or said fine, costs of prosecution, and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

SECTION V

This ordinance and the various parts, sections, subsections, provisions, sentences and clauses are severable. If any part of this ordinance is found to be unconstitutional or invalid it is declared the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected hereby.

SECTION VI

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its publication in the _____ newspaper.
