

ORDINANCE NO. 13

An Ordinance to Regulate
the Use of Brimley Village
Mini-Park

THE TOWNSHIP OF SUPERIOR, CHIPPEWA COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

- Section 1. The Brimley Village Mini-Park shall be closed to public use between the hours of Ten O'Clock p.m. and Ten O'Clock a.m. each day. Notice of this restriction shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the park.
- Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to go upon or to use the park property during the restricted hours or to damage, vandalize, or misuse the property and its appurtenances at any time.
- Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by fine or imprisonment as provided by law or by both fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.
- Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after publication as provided by law.
